

## New Technology Coming for Safe, High-Quality Water Delivery

Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) is converting all conventional meters to Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) technology by June 2020.

PBCWUD is touting this project as being state-of-the-art technology which will efficiently deliver safe, high quality water to residents.

Data will be collected from the meter and sent through a secure network to utility data bases. The meter system transmits only the water meter readings, meter ID number, and diagnostic information to verify that the automated meter equipment is operating correctly.

Benefits of the new system include early leak detection through improved data analysis which will save consumers money and water. Currently, residents are allowed only one excessive water bill that can be waived every three years, and a bill can be high if the leak is not detected until the scheduled meter reading.

The AMI will also improve response time to water emergencies, more accurate reading of the meter, and real-time data which will allow for quicker resolutions to billing questions.

Residents will receive a letter from PBCWUD approximately 10-14 days before installation, notifying them that crews will be working in the neighborhood. On the day of installation, the PBCWUD contractor will knock on the door prior to starting the installation. The installers will be wearing a Palm Beach County-issued badge. Fraud alert: at no time will the contractor need to enter the home. Installation takes 20-30 minutes and does not require the resident to be at home. Water service will be temporarily stopped for 5-10 minutes during the installation. If the resident is not home, a notification will be placed on the front door knob indicating completion of the installation.

As you are aware, the Alliance of Delray often receives observations and concerns of area residents relating to the environment and is asked to assist in correcting problems and improving the area's appearance.

Lately, there have been several complaints regarding the appearance of the United States Post Office located at 10290 West Atlantic Avenue in Delray Beach. There is a tremendous amount of mold growing on virtually all of the surfaces of the walls and building. It has been described as an eyesore and not becoming of an official building where business of the United States of America takes place.

Attached are photos which clearly demonstrate the mold issue as well as perimeter overgrowth of weeds and vegetation.

Can you assist with obtaining the maintenance required for the building? Years ago when the Post Office sign on Atlantic Avenue was so overgrown with vegetation that motorists were passing up the entrance, Congressman Wexler assisted in having the vegetation cleared. Very little has been done to the building or grounds since then, and it shows in the attached photos.
