

The School District of Palm Beach County's Proposed 1 Mill Referendum Will be on the Ballot November 6, 2018

The School District's Referendum on this November's Ballot proposes a 1 Mill levy to continue to fund more than 650 art, music, PE, health, choice, and career education teachers, and add more school police officers and safety equipment to every school. It would also be used to hire additional mental health professionals, school counselors, school social workers and school psychologists to support the children, keep the existing teacher staff levels, and improve pay for experienced teachers. COUNTYWIDE SCHOOL QUESTION

Shall the School Board of Palm Beach County have authority to levy 1.00 mills of ad valorem millage dedicated for operational needs of District public schools to fund school safety equipment, hire additional school police and mental health professionals, fund arts, music, physical education, career and choice program teachers, and improve teacher pay beginning July 1, 2019 and automatically ending June 30, 2023, with oversight by an independent finance committee of citizens and experts?

Information on Constitutional Amendments Which Will Appear on the Ballot The Constitutional Amendments which will appear on the Ballot this November will be explained and discussed at the October 3, 2018 Alliance meeting. At the time of printing this newsletter, of the 13 Constitutional Amendments, Amendment # 8 has been removed (this amendment referred to School Board Term Limits and Duties; Public Schools). The Public may not know for sure for a few weeks which questions will be off, but pending are questions 6, 10, 13. One of the suits is for all of the multi-question amendments to be removed.

UNDERSTANDING "CONCURRENCY" AND "PROPORTIONATE SHARE"

Florida Statute 163.3180 Concurrency.—

5. (h)1.(c

Allow an applicant for a development-of-regional-impact development order, development agreement, rezoning, or other land use development permit to satisfy the transportation concurrency requirements of the local comprehensive plan, the local government's concurrency management system, and s. 380.06, when applicable, if:

- (I) The applicant in good faith offers to enter into a binding agreement to pay for or construct its proportionate share of required improvements in a manner consistent with this subsection.
- (II) The proportionate-share contribution or construction is sufficient to accomplish one or more mobility improvements that will benefit a regionally significant transportation facility. A local government may accept contributions from multiple applicants for a planned improvement if it maintains contributions in a separate account designated for that purpose.
- 5.(i)...Any alternative mobility funding system adopted may not be used to deny, time, or phase an application for site plan approval, plat approval, final subdivision approval, building permits, or the functional equivalent of such approvals provided that the developer agrees to pay for the development's identified transportation impacts via the funding mechanism implemented by the local government...

Do You Have Informed Delivery?

Informed Delivery is a free and optional notification service that gives residential consumers the ability to digitally preview their letter-size mail pieces and manage their packages that are scheduled to arrive soon. Informed Delivery makes mail more convenient by allowing users to view what is coming to their mailbox whenever, wherever — even while traveling — on a computer, tablet, or mobile device.

To automate the sortation and delivery of mail, the United States Postal Service® (USPS) digitally images the fronts of letter-size mail pieces that run through automation equipment. USPS is now using those images to provide digital notifications to users in advance of the delivery of physical mail.


