Sober Homes Discussed at December Meeting

The December meeting of the Alliance provided a Homeowner and Condominium Association legislative and case law update for the Membership and the invited public. Included was an update on handling sober living houses or "sober homes" in community associations. In the situation of sober homes, there can be multiple unrelated individuals living in a single family residence. Because recovering addicts are classified as disabled individuals, the residence is protected under the Federal Fair Housing Act. The goal of the sober home is to have recovering addicts live in a group setting where they receive support from other recovering individuals living in the home, thereby decreasing the likelihood of relapse among the residents.

Being proactive is the best way to manage group homes that are protected under the Federal Fair Housing Act. Successfully managing the screening process for rental and sale applications and conducting background checks on applicants is important. Nuisances such as noise and littering both of which are clear violations of the documents should be swiftly addressed. Most importantly, a community association must uniformly enforce the rules and governing documents throughout the entire community. For example, if a group home receives a violation letter because one of its residents is sitting in the front yard tossing bottles or cigarette butts on the lawn, so too should the single family home resident receive a letter if quilty of the same infraction.

Penny Surtax Update

The "one penny sales tax" is to be allotted to Palm Beach County infrastructure, updating of technology, and the school district. The planned projects timeline extends out to fiscal year (FY) 2027. 126 million dollars in Park and recreation projects is being allotted and of that, the sum of 96 million dollars is required for renovations and the sum of 30 million dollars is allotted for backlogged facilities. Old playgrounds, picnic pavilions, lighting replacement, pools and restrooms, and old boat ramps will be replaced.

Palm Beach County has 300 bridges and nearly one-third of the bridges are more than 40 years old. Modifications to the Barwick Road bridge which crosses over the Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) Canal are expected to be completed during FY 2024. The bridge on Smith Sundy Road which spans the LWDD canal and has a life span of 50 years is currently 51 years old. Modifications to this bridge are estimated to be \$600.000.

Palm Beach County maintains over 3400 miles of roadways. Resurfacing and re-striping El Clair Ranch Road from Atlantic Avenue to Boynton Beach Boulevard is one of the many projects included in the planned revitalization of approximately 2500 lane miles of County roadways. Signal modifications and upgrades are included in the One Penny Sales Surtax Project Plan. These include those signals located at Atlantic Avenue and Military Trail and Atlantic Avenue and Hamlet Drive, with each of these projects having an estimated cost of \$400,000.

Several government buildings will be renewed to some extent including the South County Administrative Complex which will undergo redevelopment in FY 2020 with an estimated cost of \$6,000,000.

The Palm Beach County Property Appraiser's Office is taking applications for Homestead Exemptions for the 2019 tax year.

In order to qualify, you must:

- √ Hold title to the property as of January 1, 2019
- √ Be a permanent resident of the State of Florida as of January 1, 2019

Additional items that apply to you:

- Social Security Number of all property owners who are applying and spouse.
- 2. A valid Florida driver's license or ID.
- A valid Florida vehicle registration or Florida voters' registration. (Voting address must match homestead.)
