Rep. Frankel Secures Billions in New Funding for Early Childcare

Congresswoman Lois Frankel (FL-21), held a press conference at the Head Start YWCA program to talk about the \$11.5 billion she secured for Head Start and \$7.7 billion for child care and development Block Grants, helping working families afford quality child care. “Every child deserves quality early education and working families need to have safe, nurturing places for their children. Childcare is an economic issue as much as a child care issue”, said the Congresswoman.

Rep. Frankel Re-Introduces the Women’s Health Protection Act at Press Conference

Congresswoman Lois Frankel (FL-21), held a press conference on re-introduction of the Women’s Health Protection Act and to oppose the statewide abortion bans that are sweeping the nation’s legislatures. “We are at war-not with a foreign adversary,” said the Congresswoman. This Act is a federal safeguard against the erosion of abortion access. It would protect health care providers’ ability to deliver abortion services free from medically unnecessary and onerous restrictions. Since 2010, more than 400 laws have been passed that restrict and regulate abortion for medically unnecessary reasons. These regulations are lessening the quality of health care women receive.

The Congresswoman also discussed possible hearings that would be held, and John Hulik shared his concerns and suggestions for better ways to use that money for long term positive outcomes for those struggling with addiction.

The Congresswoman met with local doctors to hear their concerns and ideas to ensure that everyone has access to quality healthcare. The discussion included ensuring access to more mental health providers as well as best practices to treat addiction.
