5 Day Sales Tax Holiday August 2- August 6, 2019 The time to buy computers and computer-related accessories!

During the 2019 Back-to-School Sales Tax Holiday, certain clothing, footwear, and accessories selling for \$60 or less per item, certain school supplies selling for \$15 or less per item, and personal computers and related accessories purchased for noncommercial home or personal use having a sales price of \$1,000 or less per item, are exempt from sales tax. The holiday period begins at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, August 2, 2019, and ends at 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, August 6, 2019.

There is no limit on the amount of items that may be purchased. Be aware that a manufacturer's coupon or rebate could affect the taxable price because the store is being reimbursed from the manufacturer and the savings amount from the coupon or rebate would need to be added to the cost of the item to determine the final taxable price. If the department store or retailer provides a discount and the final price falls below the threshold for the items, the item could be exempt from the tax.

If a rain check is issued during a sales tax holiday, and the item is purchased after the holiday, the item is subject to the sales tax. However, layaway items purchased during a sales tax holiday are not subject to the tax.

Mail order, catalog, and Internet sales are not subject to the sales tax during the sales tax holiday when the order is accepted for immediate shipment even if it is shipped after the holiday. Be aware that shipping charges are considered part of the sales price and need to be proportionately allocated to each item to determine if the sales tax applies.

Another Win for Alliance Communities! Reprieve from Retrofitting of Sprinkler Systems

Alliance Member communities with high rises 75 feet or higher and constructed prior to 1992 now have an additional four years for retrofitting a fire sprinkler system or installing Engineered Life Safety Systems (ELSS). Thank you Governor DeSantis for signing HB 7103!

The Alliance will continue to work for a complete "opt out" of these requirements in future legislative sessions.

Reminder: Trim Notice Coming Soon!


Palm Beach County Property Appraiser Dorothy Jacks' Office has submitted the 2019 preliminary tax roll to Florida's Department of Revenue and the local taxing authorities. Palm Beach County-wide property (taxable) values have increased 6.21% from 2018 to 2019.

Taxing authorities will use these values to help them prepare for their upcoming budgets and to determine their proposed millage (tax) rates.

Once the tax roll receives approval from the Florida Department of Revenue (usually in late July), the Property Appraiser's Office will prepare the "Truth In Millage" (TRIM) Notices for Palm Beach County residents, which are mailed in mid-August.



It's Sea Turtle Nesting Season!

Help to protect Florida's wildlife treasures by not disturbing or removing eggs from sea turtle nests. Reduce the number of lights near nesting beaches to a minimum. Consider using motion detection lights and turtle-friendly lights that concentrate light downward. To block indoor light from reaching beaches, apply window tint and keep drapes drawn. About Storm Surge

Play it Safe When Local Officials order an evacuation. Evaculate!

- Six inches of Storm
 Surge can knock People
 Off Their Feet
- One Foot of Storm Surge can Float Many Vehicles
- Two Feet Can Sweep a Car Off the Road
- Debris in the Water Makes it even More Dangerous

Water in the house can be powerful. Three feet of water in a 1500 square foot home weighs 135 tons. If water destroys the ground floor of a high rise building, it can jeopardize the safety of the entire building. If you stay on an upper floor, you could be subject to higher winds and cut off from any assistance.



September Meeting to Discuss Climate Change & Sea Level Rise

September's Alliance meeting will bring two experts from the Office of Resilience (OOR) to discuss climate change and sea level rise. The OOR works to ensure that Palm Beach County remains a great place in which to live, work, and play while addressing physical, social, and economic challenges including climate change. The OOR helps the County continue to provide services, adapt to climate change, and live and operate more sustainably.

As climate change effects will impact human and natural environments, it becomes increasingly important for Palm Beach County to adapt to climate change, mitigate climate change impacts, develop sustainably, and thereby reduce resident, business, and natural resource vulnerability. Palm Beach County is at the forefront of local government planning for resilience and climate change adaptation.

Governor DeSantis Creates Statewide Opioid Task Force

The Alliance of Delray actively participates in State Attorney Dave Aronberg's Sober Home Task Force. State Attorney Aronberg is doing a phenomenal job working on solving problems associated with Palm Beach County's opioid epidemic. Understanding that limiting substance abuse and combating the opioid epidemic in Florida is a critical public health issue, and recognizing the urgency and importance of continuing efforts against substance abuse, Governor Ron DeSantis has created a state wide Opioid Task Force to combat Florida's substance abuse crisis.

Governor DeSantis created the Office of Drug Control within the Executive Office of the Governor for the purpose of researching and assessing the nature of opioid abuse, and coordinating and centralizing efforts to treat and prevent substance abuse in the State. Among the goals of the office is to gather information, develop a statewide prevention strategy, and identify funding to limit substance abuse.
