Until the first of next year, state patrol officers, as well as local police and sheriff's department officials are issuing warning tickets for those stopped while texting and driving. The new law making texting while driving a primary offense went into effect July 1. It provides for an education period and warnings until Jan. 1, then enforcement with fines after that.
