

VOLUNTEER MARINE UNIT

Our Volunteer Marine Unit saved a life!

While on patrol, one of our volunteers heard a call on the radio of a person who needed immediate help in the water. Without thinking about it, he went to the location and found the woman in the water holding on with one hand from the jet ski she had fallen from. She was swallowing water and gasping for air. We found out later that she did not know how to swim. Our volunteer Marine Unit was able to retrieve her from the water and Fire Rescue was able to help her. Hopefully the community understands the impact our volunteers make on a daily basis -- this is just one of many great examples. VERT

Our Volunteer Emergency Response Team received a “Special Appreciation” award recognizing the time and dedication they put into the School Traffic Safety Unit. Every year, our VERT Unit volunteers for the schools and helps control the traffic for the children during the first week of school to ensure our Palm Beach County students get to school in a safe manner.



NEW CARS

PBSO Volunteers put hundreds of hours monthly into our Citizen Patrol Cars. Because of their time put into these cars, the Sheriff’s Office was able to supply them with 23 brand new vehicles in 2019!
