Week Seven of the 2020 legislative session was relatively quiet with committee meetings and session in both chambers.

Both the House and the Senate held session on Wednesday where Senators' Rader, Powell and Harrell along with Representative Roth had bills heard for final passage, now on to the Governor for signature.

This was a quiet week for budget negotiations, appropriation committee chairs and staff are working behind the scenes to come up with allocations for each area to bring into conference which is the next step for House and Senate negotiators. The legislature is charged with passing a final budget before the March 13 end of the Legislative Session. The 2020-2021 fiscal year will start on July 1.
