- Beginning Monday, July 6, the request to modify the effective date will no longer be available online, but instead need to be made by calling 1-833-FL-APPLY (1-833-352-7759) and choosing option 5.
- Please be aware that the work search and work registration requirements for claimants expires Saturday, July 4, 2020, unless the Governor directs DEO to extend it.
- Palm Beach County & Broward County have implemented mask requirements. Below you will find more information on them.
- Broward County and Palm Beach County Beaches will be closed from Friday, July 3, 2020, through Sunday, July 5, 2020.

# REPORT COVID-19 VIOLATIONS

## HOW DO I REPORT A BUSINESS THAT ISN'T FOLLOWING COVID-19 ORDERS?

### BROWARD COUNTY

Broward residents can anonymously report violations by following these steps:

#### ONLINE

- Go to [MyBroward.Broward.org](http://MyBroward.Broward.org)
- Select "Request for Service"
- Enter the location of the violation, and select "COVID-19 Business Complaints" as the Type of Issue.

#### BY PHONE

- Dial the Broward County Call Center at 311 or 954-831-4000

### PALM BEACH COUNTY

Palm Beach County residents can utilize the public hotline to report businesses that may not be following guidelines. If you witness a business in Palm Beach County that is not enforcing COVID-19 related guidelines, such as requiring staff and patrons to wear face coverings or social distancing, you can report it by:
