Next Tuesday, December 15th, is the final day you can [sign up for an affordable health care plan](#) for 2021 under the Affordable Care Act (ACA).

Most Americans qualify for financial help from the federal government through the ACA that will lower the cost of their health care premiums. So, if you lost your job along with your health coverage or are simply looking for an affordable plan, the deadline to sign up is next Tuesday, December 15th. If you miss this deadline you won't be able to enroll unless you have a [life changing event](#) – like losing your job or getting married.

This week, I hosted a [virtual discussion](#) with experts from Florida Covering Kids and Families and Epilepsy Florida to discuss how uninsured Floridians can get access to health care for the upcoming year, including where they can find help to walk them through this process.
