## **Publix Pharmacies Providing Vaccines**

All 67 Publix Pharmacies in Palm Beach County will be providing vaccinations starting tomorrow, January 21st.

Appointments can be made today, January 20th, online only, by visiting: <u>https://www.publix.com/covid-vaccine/florida</u>. Appointments cannot be made by calling Publix or the Publix Pharmacy. No vaccinations will be given without appointments.

According to the Governor's order, only the following persons are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine at this time:

- healthcare personnel with direct patient contact
- residents and staff of long term healthcare facilities, and
- adults aged 65 years and older

You can find your nearest Publix by visiting publix.com/locations.

Publix has a goal of vaccinating as many as 125 people a day at each of its' 67 stores.

As supplies increase, we in the County have plans to open mass vaccination sites at the South Florida Fairgrounds, the South County Civic Center and other locations. I will keep you informed.

Points of Distribution Sites (PODS) have been successful at senior communities such as Kings Point Golf and Country Club and both Century Villages in West Boca Raton and West Palm Beach. PODS are being established at sites in large County Clubs and HOA's throughout the County in anticipation of increased vaccine supply.


