Important COVID-19 Vaccine Update

February 23, 2021

Governor announces today **CVS Pharmacy** becomes a Vaccine provider

CVS Pharmacies will become a point of distribution (POD) to administer the COVID-19 vaccine in 19 pharmacies across Florida with 1 located in Palm Beach County. CVS will begin accepting appointments on Wednesday, February 24, 2021.

Federal Vaccine Relief

FEMA will provide additional COVID-19 vaccine relief. There will be four massive vaccine sites in Miami, Tampa, Jacksonville and Orlando. These sites will provide up to 2,000 vaccines per day, 7-days a week. Each of the four locations will have the ability to send out mobile units to provide additional vaccinations beyond the city's limits. These locations are expected to open next week.

Vaccines will be available to law enforcement officers, teachers and fire fighters of age 50 and older. These points of distributions are available to all Floridians who are eligible for the vaccine.
