Here's good news for Floridians who may have lost their jobs and health care due to COVID-19, and anyone looking to lower premiums and/or copays: The Biden Administration has opened a [Special Enrollment Period for the Affordable Care Act](#). It allows folks who are uninsured or want less costly health insurance to sign up for affordable coverage from **February 15th through May 15th**.

And more good news: Most people who enroll in the Affordable Care Act marketplace are eligible for financial assistance from the federal government that may lower their health insurance costs significantly.
