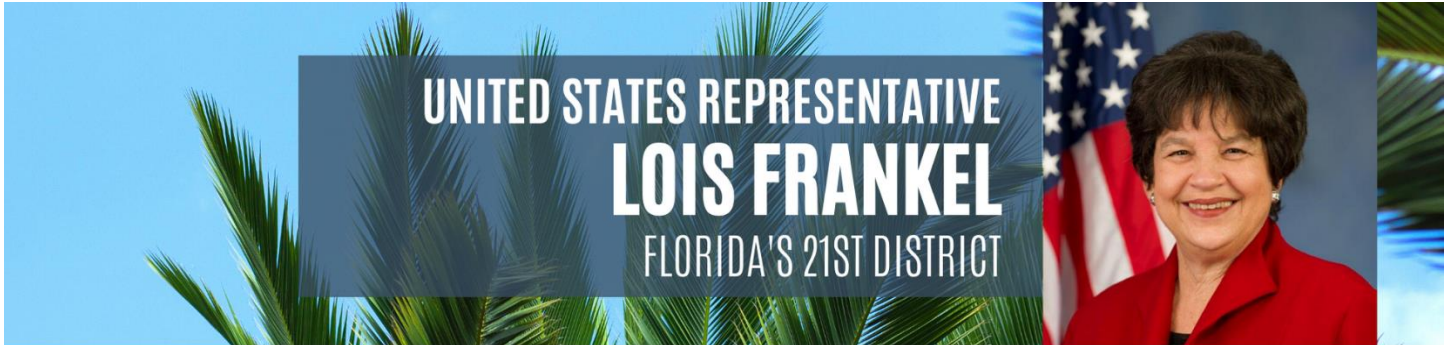

## Rep. Frankel Introduces Bipartisan Legislation to Support Student Veterans



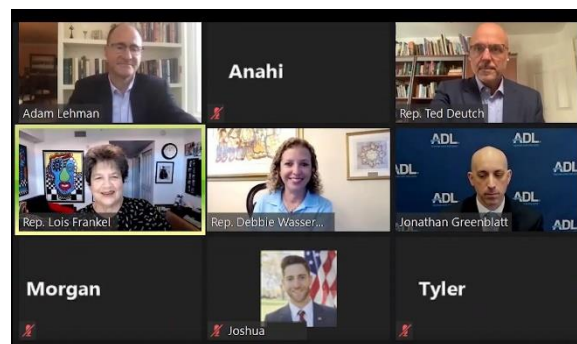
On Thursday, June 3rd, Congresswoman Lois Frankel (FL-21) held a press conference at the Palm Beach State College Veterans' Center to announce the introduction of the *Veterans Education Empowerment Act*, a bipartisan, bicameral bill co-led by Rep. Michael Waltz (FL-06) and Senators Jacky Rosen (D-NV) and Marco Rubio (R-FL) to support student veterans by authorizing grants to create, maintain, and operate Student Veteran Centers at universities and colleges across the nation. Services at these centers will give a boost to student veterans transitioning from military to civilian life.
