Do you have LEG PAIN? You may be at risk for Peripheral Arterial Disease.

Approximately 8 million people in the United States have Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD), including 12-20% of individuals older than age 60.

Risk factors include: Smoking, Diabetes, Obesity, Age >55, Hypertension, High Cholesterol, Family History of CAD, PVD or Stroke, Coronary Artery Disease (CAD).

PAD Symptoms:

Pain or cramping in the buttocks, thighs or calves when walking

Leg fatigue or heaviness

Pain in the feet while at rest

Numbness or tingling in the legs or feet

Burning or tingling in the feet

Loss of hair on the feet or toes

Coldness in the lower legs or feet

Weak pulse in the legs or feet

Ulcers or sores in the legs and feet
