



Dear Neighbor,

Good news! Last week, the Social Security Administration [announced](#) that the cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) will increase by nearly 6% per person, meaning that millions of retired seniors across America will see a bump in their assistance. For example, if you are currently receiving \$1,700 per month in Social Security, your monthly benefit will increase by \$100 next year.



If you or your loved ones receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI), you will see the change on December 30th, and all Social Security beneficiaries will see the increase in January.

I'm also working with likeminded members in Congress to protect these benefits for future generations, and for seniors who rely on these benefits now. My colleagues and I will be introducing the *Social Security 2100: A Sacred Trust Act* soon, which will improve Social Security's long-term financing and make sure millionaires and billionaires pay their fair share so all Americans can retire with dignity. This critical bill will also increase benefits across the board for anyone on Social Security, ensure the annual COLA accurately adjusts for

inflation, increases the minimum payment for low-income earners, [and much more](#).

Social Security is our nation's most important program for older Americans, and I look forward to continuing to advocate for these benefits on behalf of our Palm Beach County seniors.
