Special Primary Election

Primary Election Day for the Special Primary Election for U.S. House of Representatives, District 20 is Tuesday, November 2, 2021. Upon the book closing deadline (Monday, October 4), there are over 97,000 voters in PBC eligible to vote in the Special Primary Election. Florida is a "closed primary" state, meaning only the voters registered within that political party may vote in that party's Primary Election. As of 5:00p.m. this Wednesday, our Elections Office has sent over 29,000 mail ballots to voters who requested to Vote-by-Mail, and more than 2,000 have been returned.

Deadline to Request a Vote-by-Mail

PBC voters in Congressional District 20 can request a Vote-by-Mail ballot online at VotePalmBeach.gov, by email to <u>votebymail@votepalmbeach.gov</u>, or call (561) 656-6208. The deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot to be mailed to you is 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 23. A mail ballot can also be picked up in person at one of our four offices until November 1. Vote-by-Mail ballots may be returned by mail using the pre-paid postage return envelope or in person at any of our four offices during office hours. Secure drop boxes will also be available at designated drop off locations across the county.
