Great news!

I just returned from the bipartisan *Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act* signing ceremony at the White House, where President Biden signed into law a once-in-a-generation investment in our infrastructure to modernize our bridges, roads, ports, and public transportation systems while making historic investments in internet access, electric vehicles, green infrastructure, and clean drinking water—

creating millions of good paying jobs. And Florida will get roughly \$19 billion, plus the opportunity to apply for much more in grants!

The bipartisan *Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act*, also known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Framework (BIF):

- Makes the largest federal investment in public transit ever;
- Makes the largest federal investment in passenger rail since the creation of Amtrak;
- Makes the single largest dedicated bridge investment since the construction of the interstate highway system;
- Makes the largest investment in clean drinking water and waste water infrastructure in American history, delivering clean water to millions of families;
- Makes high-speed internet accessible to all Americans;

- Makes the largest investment in clean energy transmission and electric vehicle infrastructure in history; electrifying thousands of school and transit buses across the country; and creating a new Grid Deployment Authority to build a resilient, clean, 21st century electric grid.
