Important Deadlines

IMPORTANT DEADLINE! Monday, December 13, 2021 is the deadline to register or change your party affiliation to vote in the upcoming Special General Election for U.S. House of Representatives, District 20, and the Special Democratic Primary Election for Florida House of Representatives, District 88. Make sure your voter registration information is up to date and, if you aren't sure whether you live within Congressional District 20 or Florida House District 88, visit the "My Status" page at VotePalmBeach.gov. You can also look at your voter registration card to see what districts you are in. Election Day is January 11, 2022.
