Voting by mail in Palm Beach County is convenient, reliable, and secure in the upcoming Special General Elections for U.S. Congressional District 20 and the Special Democratic Primary Election for Florida House District 88. Voters registered in these districts may request a Vote-by-Mail ballot online at VotePalmBeach.gov, by emailing votebymail@votepalmbeach.gov, or by calling (561) 656-6208. The deadline to request a mail ballot to be mailed to you is 5:00p.m. on January 1, 2022. However, a ballot can be picked up in person at one of our four office locations through 5:00p.m. on January 10, 2022.
