Important Vote-by-Mail Information

Election Day is tomorrow, Tuesday, January 11, 2022, in the Special General Election for U.S. Congressional District 20 and Special Primary Election for Florida House District 88. If you still have your mail ballot and have not returned it yet, we recommend that you do not mail your ballot; instead, bring your completed mail ballot to any of our designated drop off locations. Drop boxes are located at each Early Voting location during Early Voting hours or outside each of our four offices. Vote-by-Mail ballots must be received by our office by 7PM on Election Day.
