## Tallahassee Tracker Redistricting Update

On Wednesday, the Florida House voted 77-39, along party lines, to pass **CS/SJR 100**, which includes the Senate and House maps. On Thursday, a unanimous Senate



approved a Florida House map and gave final approval to a Senate map. The new configurations now go to the Florida Supreme Court for a final review before it becomes law and takes effect for the 2022 election cycle. In Congressional redistricting news, Governor DeSantis asked the Florida Supreme Court to advise on whether or not a 200-mile congressional district linking minority neighborhoods in North Florida must be kept intact. As a result, Congressional redistricting efforts were postponed as the Congressional Redistricting Subcommittee canceled Friday's meeting while it waits until the Florida Supreme Court issues guidance.
