

Voting By Mail in the March 8, 2022 Elections How to request, return, & track your mail ballot

March 8, 2022, is Election Day in the Special General Election for Florida House District 88 and 19 municipalities across Palm Beach County.

Voting by mail is convenient, secure, and reliable, and your Elections Office provides several safe and easy ways to request and return your mail ballot.

Requesting your Vote-by-Mail Ballot

If you haven't already requested your Vote-by-Mail ballot, you may request a mail ballot online at <u>VotePalmBeach.gov</u>, by emailing <u>votebymail@votepalmbeach.gov</u>, or by calling (561) 656-6208. Voters must provide their Florida Driver's License or Florida ID, or the last four digits of their Social Security Number when making their request.

The deadline to request that a Vote-by-Mail ballot be mailed to you is 5:00 p.m. on February 26, 2022. If you miss the deadline, you may pick up a Vote-by-Mail ballot in person at one of our four (4) offices through 5:00 p.m. on March 7, 2022.

Returning your Vote-by-Mail Ballot

Vote-by-Mail ballots can be returned by mail using the pre-paid postage return envelope or in person at any of our four (4) offices during office hours.

Secure drop boxes will be available from February 26, 2022, through March 6, 2022, at designated drop off locations across the county, including:

- All four (4) of the county's Early Voting locations during Early Voting hours.
- The secure official drop box located outside each of our Main, South, and North County Elections offices or inside of our West County Elections Office.

Vote-by-Mail ballots must be received by our main office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, March 8, 2022.

Drop box locations and hours were established pursuant to Senate Bill 90 (2021) and state law.

Tracking Your Vote-by-Mail Ballot

You can track your Vote-by-Mail ballot from the moment you request it until the time we receive it back at our office. Visit the "My Status" page at <u>VotePalmBeach.gov</u> to track your ballot to ensure your vote is processed and will be counted.

Informed Delivery

Your Palm Beach County Elections Office encourages all voters to sign-up for Informed Delivery with the U.S. Postal Service. Informed Delivery is a secure, FREE feature that provides eligible residential consumers with a digital preview of their incoming mail and packages.

You can conveniently view what's arriving in your mailbox via email notifications, an online dashboard, or mobile app. As a voter, you will have a more convenient and secure "vote at home" experience,

Important Dates & Deadlines

The deadline to register to vote was February 7, 2022.

The deadline to request that a Vote-by-Mail ballot be mailed to you is 5:00 p.m. on February 26, 2022.

Vote-by-Mail ballots must be received by our main office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, March 8, 2022.

Early Voting is available Saturday, February 26, through Sunday, March 6, 2022. Early Voting locations are open from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Election Day is Tuesday, March 8, 2022. Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
