Tallahassee Tracker Bills of Interest

This week, the House was in session and voted on several impactful bills. After many hours of debate, **HB7** passed 74-41. The bill would prohibit lessons and trainings that teach that



some people are morally superior to members of another race, color, sex, or national origin. Additionally, it would ban teachings that an individual is inherently racist, sexist, or oppressive, whether consciously or unconsciously. Opponents say the bill shields people who don't want to hear inconvenient truths about American history and society. While the bill passed along party lines, Democrats successfully passed three amendments to the bill, including two regarding African studies, and one that would allow schools to teach how slavery, oppression, segregation, and discrimination has impacted people's individual freedoms.

HB1557, what some refer to as the "Don't Say Gay" bill, is a bill that limits discussions of sexual orientation and gender identity in schools, a measure that has drawn widespread criticism from
