IMPORTANT VOTER INFORMATION

**March 8th is Election Day in
Parts of Palm Beach County
Make Your Vote Count**

Election Day is March 8, 2022, in Palm Beach County for 19 municipalities and a Special General Election for House District 88. Voters in House District 88 or these municipalities will be voting on candidates and/or municipal questions.

There are 3 secure, easy, and convenient ways to vote in the March 8th Elections: By mail, at a designated Early Voting location, or at your polling place on Election Day.

Voting by Mail

- The deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot to be mailed to you for the March 8th Elections was 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 26, 2022. However, a ballot can be picked up in person at one of our four office locations during office hours through 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 7, 2022.
- If you still have your mail ballot and have not returned it yet, you can drop your mail ballot off at any of our secure Vote-by-Mail ballot drop boxes. Drop boxes are located at each Early Voting location during Early Voting hours or at each of our four offices. Don't forget to seal and sign the back of the return Vote-by-Mail envelope before mailing or delivering it to our office.

- As of today, we recommend that you do not mail your ballot, but instead bring your completed mail ballot to any of our designated drop off locations.
- Please note that Vote-by-Mail ballots must be received by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day for your vote to count.

- You can track your Vote-by-Mail ballot from the moment it is requested until the time we receive it back at our office. Simply go to the "My Status" page on our [website](#).

Early Voting

- Registered voters eligible to vote in the March 8th Elections can vote at any designated Early Voting location.
- Early Voting will be available at four different locations through Sunday, March 6, 2022. Early voting locations will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Please remember to bring your photo and signature ID.

Election Day

- Election Day is Tuesday, March 8, 2022. Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- On Election Day, you must vote at your assigned polling place. You can find your polling place on your Voter Registration Card or you may enter your voter information at www.votepalmbeach.gov/Voters/Precinct-Finder.
- Remember to bring a valid photo and signature ID.

Safe Voting Reminders:

- Our Elections Team is committed to following all COVID-19 safety protocols and CDC guidelines to ensure the health and wellness of voters, poll workers, and employees.
- Poll workers will be wearing masks, practicing social distancing, and sanitizing voting booths and common areas throughout the day.

FSE Student Scholarships

Apply Today! Deadline Is March 11, 2022

The Florida Supervisors of Elections (FSE) will offer four \$1,200 scholarships to college students.

Applicants must be registered Florida voters and have lived in the state for at least the two preceding years. Applicants must be either a Political Science, Public Administration, Business Administration, or Journalism/Mass Communication major, and be at least a junior in college. Students must be enrolled or accepted as a full-time student in an accredited college or university in Florida, and have at least a "C" average for the previous year.

Applications must be submitted to the Elections Office of the county in which the applicant is registered to vote. Each county will select one finalist to send to the FSE Scholarship Committee for consideration. Scholarship applications must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 11, 2022 in the SOE Main Office, located at 240 South Military

Trail, West Palm Beach. Letters of recommendation MUST accompany the application or be received by the deadline.

The Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Office will review all applications, interview students, and select one finalist. That student's application, with our written recommendation and verification of voter registration, will be forwarded to the FSE Scholarship Committee. The Committee will select four (4) scholarship winners from the finalists.
