## Flint Pen Strand of Corkscrew Regional Ecosystem Watershed to Re-Open

Public access to the Flint Pen Strand Unit of the Corkscrew Regional Watershed Ecosystem (CREW) in Lee and Collier Counties will re-open today, Friday, April 8, at 5 p.m. Public access was temporarily closed due to wildfires.

A temporary burn ban remains in place on SFWMD lands in Lee, Collier and Hendry Counties due to dry conditions.
