

Legislative Redistricting Update

The legislative redistricting process concluded last week after state lawmakers returned to Tallahassee for a Special Session to redraw congressional district maps. Senate Bill 2C was signed into law on April 22nd, which contains the new congressional districts. On April 25th, Florida's Governor also signed into law Senate Bill 524, which contains several changes to election laws affecting voting processes, accessibility, and oversight. Although both of these bills were signed into law, the provisions of each are subject to change due to pending litigation.
