

New Election Requirements Still Apply

Recently, an appellate court reinstated challenged provisions of Senate Bill 90. Signed into law after the 2021 Legislative Session, sections of SB90 relating to voting by mail, 3rd party voter registration organizations, and other changes affecting voters and the voting process were struck down by a lower court in March. As such, the new requirements that your PBC Elections Office enacted this year will continue to apply through the upcoming midterm elections, and we'll now implement the provisions of SB524 that had earlier been deemed unenforceable.
