Secure Ballot Intake Stations

SAME BOX, DIFFERENT NAME. Your Palm Beach County Elections Office will have Secure Ballot Intake Stations available at our offices and Early Voting location across the county during designated times in the upcoming 2022 Primary and General Elections. Secure Ballot Intake Stations, formerly known as "Drop Boxes," give voters another convenient way to securely drop off their Vote-by-Mail ballot besides returning it by mail using the pre-paid postage return envelope, at any Early Voting location during Early Voting hours, or at one of our four offices during office hours. The name change is due to legislation recently signed into law.
