
# **Friendly Reminder**

#### DISASTER PREPAREDNESS SALES TAX HOLIDAY

During the 2023 Florida Disaster Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday, you may purchase qualifying items related to disaster preparedness exempt from sales tax. The exemption period will begin Saturday, August 26 and extend through Friday, September 8. During this time, I encourage residents to take time to finalize their disaster supply kits and take advantage of these tax holidays in preparation for hurricane season.

# Vote-by-Mail Ballots: Information from the PBC Supervisor of Elections

If you received a Vote-by-Mail ballot in 2022 and you have not renewed your request since November 9th, your mail ballot request has expired. New Florida Laws require voters who are interested in voting by mail to request a new mail ballot after each General Election cycle.

If you want to receive a Vote-by-Mail ballot for the 2024 elections, you will need to complete a new request.

There are three upcoming elections in 2024 in which voters will have an opportunity to cast their ballot, including a Presidential Preference Primary (PPP) on March 19th, a Primary Election on August 20th, and the General Election on November 5th. The Presidential Preference Primary on March 19th will coincide with local municipal elections. If you want to vote by mail for any of these elections, please request your mail ballot today.

# **Property Fraud Alert Registration**


Your home is one of your biggest investments and to help you protect that investment, I recommend that you sign up for Property Fraud Alert. What is Property Fraud Alert? It is a free service offered by the Palm Beach County Clerk of the Circuit Court & Comptroller that will protect your property from fraud by monitoring the documents that are recorded in the Official Records of the Clerk. It is free to register, and it only takes a few minutes to complete.


To sign up, visit the Clerk's website at

www.mypalmbeachclerk.com/services/property-fraud-alert.

Once you sign up, you will receive an alert either by email or phone, when there is activity associated with your property. This could save valuable time to stop criminals in their tracks if the activity is not

initiated by you. I've signed up and I have peace of mind knowing that I will be alerted should there be fraudulent activity associated with my property. You should too!

This month, I attended several events around Senate District 26, as well as the National Conference of State Legislatures in Indianapolis!


