


## Clerk's Office Raises Money for Charities at Annual Money Drop

## Important Changes to Property Documents with Witnesses



Are you planning on buying, selling or making changes to property in Palm Beach County?

You need to know about a <u>new witness address requirement</u> that will affect all property transactions in Florida beginning in 2024.

Starting January 1, 2024, certain documents recorded in Palm Beach County's Official Records or anywhere in our state must include the post office address of each witness in addition to the witness's name.
