### Executive Director's Annual Report to Landowners

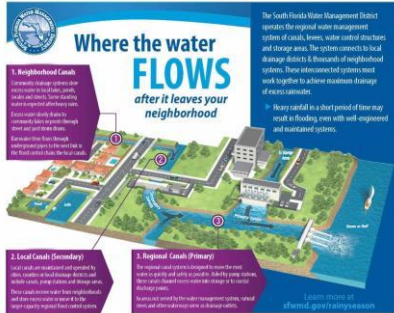
