The Palm Beach County Engineering & Public Works Department was asked to share an update about the Lyons Road project to widen from 2- to 4-lanes between the LWDD L-38 Canal and Atlantic Avenue. Here is the update since Mayor Sachs' 1/26/24 Traffic Workshop:

- The contractor was able to remove barricades from all lanes south of about 156th Ct S this week. All northbound and southbound lanes are fully opened from this area south and will only experience intermittent closures as work is completed.
- Crews are working on the sidewalk along the east side of Lyons Road between St. Mary's and Joseph's Market.
 The asphalt crew paved the turn lanes and median crossover at Mizner Country Club this week.
 Crews are doing prep work at the intersection of Atlantic Avenue and Lyons Road for the widening that needs to occur there. The barricades in that area will remain until the intersection work is completed, which is expected July 2024.
- Intermittent lane closures around the Atlantic Avenue and Lyons Road intersection are expected in mid February as the contractors progress in construction.
