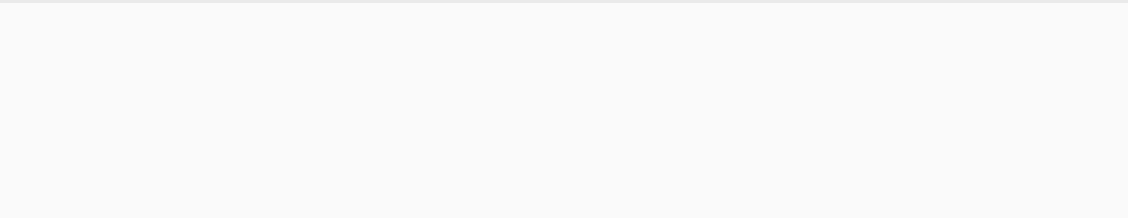
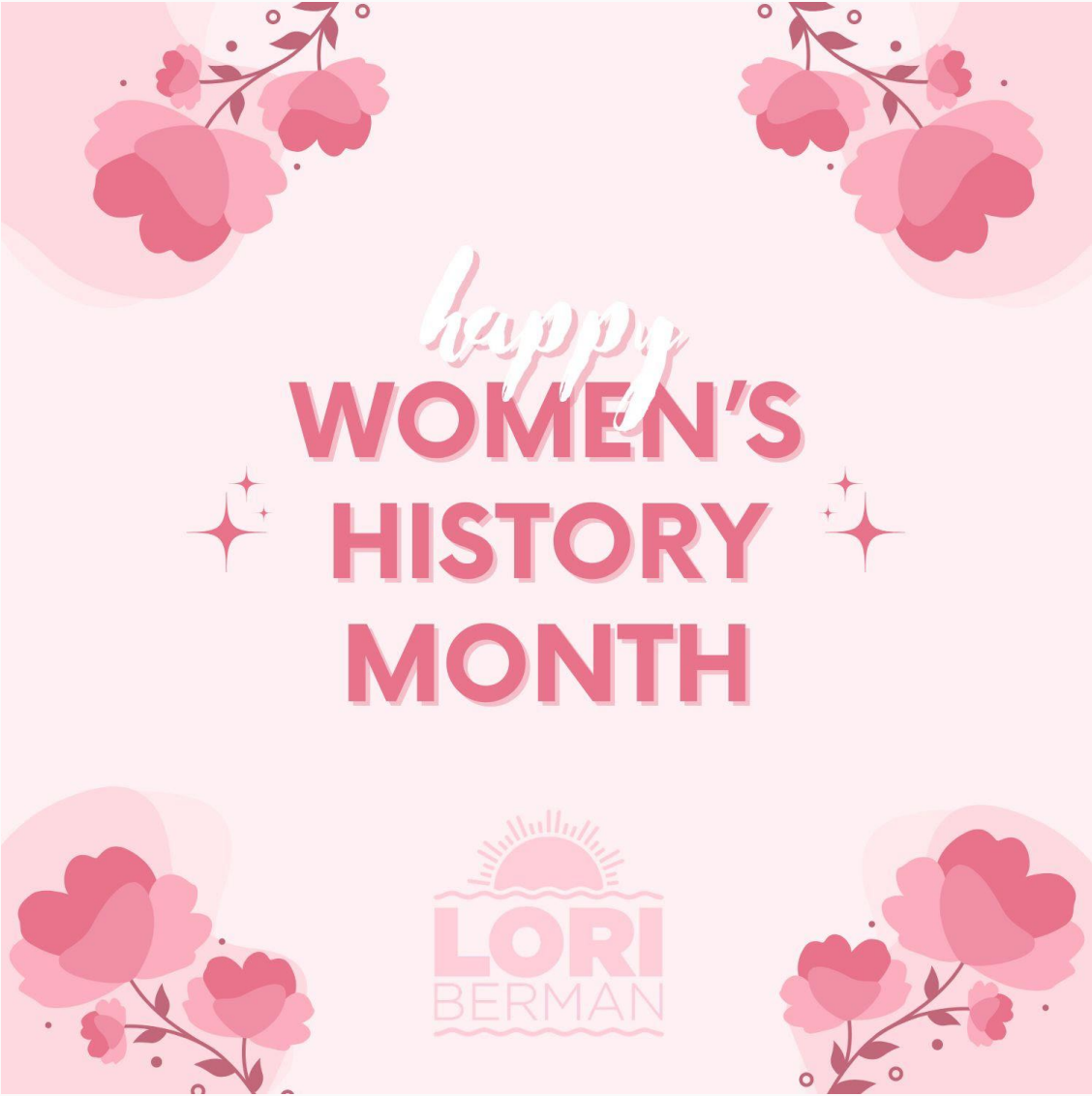
HAPPY ISRAEL DAY AT THE CAPITOL

STATE LEGISLATORS GATHERED TODAY TO SUPPORT THE STATE OF ISRAEL AND NAME 2/29 AS ISRAEL DAY AT THE CAPITOL



On Thursday, many legislators gathered on the steps of the Capitol to show the State of Florida's support for Israel. We heard from survivors of the horrific October 7th terrorist attack and their stories from that day. The Miami Israel Consul General Maor Elbaz-Starinsky helped organize this event and spoke of Florida and Israel's longstanding alliance. Over half a million Jews live in Florida, many of whom have reported a significant rise in antisemitic speech and incidents since the October 7th attack. The bill I have sponsored, SB 148: Antisemitism, that has now passed the Senate and House floors will help combat antisemitism in Florida and keep our Jewish population safe.

Some words from my speech on Thursday: "As we celebrate this day, let us recommit ourselves to strengthening the bond between Florida and Israel. Let us continue to stand together united in our shared values and unwavering support for Israel and the Jewish community."
