## **Legislative & Budget Update**

Since our last update, we are awaiting for my 4 passed bills to be signed by the Governor. In the meantime, I have been providing legislative updates throughout the various cities I represent. If you would like more information on when and where my next presentation will be, please call my office.

We are currently awaiting budget updates from the Governor. We expect that any day now we will receive a budget veto list from him as well as a signed budget.

# Vote-by-Mail Ballots: Information from the PBC Supervisor of Elections

If you received a Vote-by-Mail ballot in 2022 and you have not renewed your request since November 9th, your mail ballot request has expired. New Florida Laws require voters who are interested in voting by mail to request a new mail ballot after each General Election cycle.

If you want to receive a Vote-by-Mail ballot for the 2024 elections, you will need to complete a new request.

There are two upcoming elections in 2024 in which voters will have an opportunity to cast their ballot, including a Primary Election on August 20th, and the General Election on November 5th. The Presidential Preference Primary on March 19th will coincide with local municipal elections. If you want to vote by mail for any of these elections, please request your mail ballot today.

## UPDATE FROM FLORIDA SUPREME COURT

After months of petition gathering, widespread support and legal deliberations on a ballot amendment to preserve abortion access in Florida's Constitution, the Florida Supreme Court today released an opinion approving the petition for the November ballot.

Abortion is OFFICIALLY on the ballot this November! But the Florida Supreme Court decision also triggered the 6-week abortion ban to go into effect, devastating reproductive care in Florida. Novembers election will be crucial in protecting the reproductive rights of women in the state of Florida.



# STATEMENT: Senator Lori Berman Applauds Florida Supreme Court's Decision to Add Abortion to the Ballot in November

I commend the Florida Supreme Court for recognizing the will of the more than 1.2 million Floridians who want to preserve abortion access in Florida's Constitution. This is not just a victory for women's reproductive rights, but also a crucial step towards upholding the principles established in Roe v. Wade.

Floridians want the right to make decisions about one's own body without government interference. It is fundamental to individual autonomy and dignity Reproductive choices such as abortion are decisions between a woman and he physician. And now in November, Floridians will choose to enshrine that fundamental right in the Constitution.
