Property fraud is a growing concern, with scammers increasingly targeting homeowners by filing fraudulent documents to sell or transfer ownership of their property.

The Clerk's office provides a free [Property Fraud Alert service](#) that notifies the recipient whenever a document is recorded with their name, business name, address or parcel number. This early warning system can help homeowners act quickly if they become the target of fraudulent activity.
