Speaker: Joshua Gerstin, Esq. of Gerstin & Associates Community Association 2024:

September's Meeting Will Provide Essential Information on New Condominium and Homeowners Association Law

Known as "Condo 3.0," the recently passed legislation affecting condominium association (COA) is extensive. Homeowners Associations as well received extra regulations.

Attend the September 4, 2024 Alliance Membership meeting to hear and understand more about the legislative changes that were enacted on July 1, 2024. For COA's, these new laws have made changes to Community Association Managers, Milestone Inspections, Official Records, Criminal Violations, Budgets, Financial Reporting, Reserves, Meetings of the COA's, Director Education, Voting Process, Hurricane Protections, SLAPP and Defamation Suits, Division of Condominium, Timeshares and Mobile Homes turnover jurisdiction. Other bills, i.e. CS/CS/HB 1503 regarding COA Insurance and HB 1028 regarding COA's and My Safe Florida Home will be discussed as well.

Homeowner Association (HOA) changes in regulations will also be covered. For example, CS/CS/HB 1203 regarding HOA's discussion will include changes in Community Association Managers, Official Records, Criminal Violations, Assisting Law Enforcement, Financial Reporting, Requirement to Provide Accounting, Education for Officers and Directors, Enforcement of Covenants and Rules, Fines, Suspensions, Liens, Parking Regulations, Electronic Voting, and Assessments.

This will be an extraordinarily informative meeting which will provide information for residents as well as community leaders. Spread the word and encourage your members to attend.

President Lori Vinikoor called the meeting to order at 9:30 AM. Palm Beach County Fire Rescue (PBCFR) held a Presentation of Colors Ceremony for the assembled. Palm Beach Sheriff's Office District 4 Captain Rob Sandt reported that the crime statistics for the past month are down, as are the number of vehicle crashes. Chief Bill Stansbury of PBCFR noted that they had fewer calls in the past month. Florida House Representative Joe Casello urged residents to vote in the upcoming elections. Hoerbiger Group Looking to Develop at Atlantic Avenue and State Road 7/441

A 197,790 square foot North America Headquarters/Office/Research/Development/Manufacturing Campus is proposed for the southeast corner of State Road 7/441 and Atlantic Avenue. The Hoerbiger Group is planning to relocate from Broward County to Palm Beach County. Hoerbiger is a multinational privately owned company founded in 1895 with its main headquarters located in Vienna, Austria and employing 6000+ workers worldwide. Within the United States, Hoerbiger's service locations include Florida, Texas, California, Wyoming, Illinois, Louisiana, and Kansas. The Company manufactures compressor components for Natural Gas, H2 and Clean Energy Industry.

The site has a Future Land Use Designation of Industrial with an exist-Ing zoning of Light Industrial. The total area is 14.23 acres. Currently, the site is approved for two buildings, one being 124,686 square feet and another being 59,095 square feet. The new application indicates one 197,790 square foot building.

Of utmost concern to the surrounding communities is the flow of traffic and completion of the expansion of Atlantic Avenue. An additional north bound right turn lane within the intersection of State Road 7/441 and Atlantic Avenue will be constructed which should alleviate some of the Issues corridor residents have in exiting their communities.

The application is expected to be presented to the Zoning Commission and Board of County Commissioners in December 2024.



About the 15 th Judicial Circuit:

Craig Williams

Craig Williams is currently a Chief Assistant State Attorney who supervises 45 felony attorneys and oversees 6 felony units. He began his law career at the Palm Beach County State Attorney's offfce in 1993 and has been a processor for almost 30 years.

Alexia Cox

Alexia Cox is Deputy Chief Assistant State Attorney at the Palm Beach County State Attorney's office where she supervises attorneys in the Domestic Violence Unit, the North and South County Satellite offices in Palm Beach Gardens and Delray Beach, the County Court Division and the Conviction Review Unit. Over her 18-year legal career, she has successfully prosecuted first degree murders, domestic violence felonies and other violent crime.

Forrest Freedman

Forrest Freedman started his legal career as an Assistant district attorney in the Bronx and Boston, Massachusetts. He has over 38 years of legal experience and has held leadership positions as the owner of Nation's Mortgage Bank, and other community activities. He was an adjunct professor at Nova Southeastern University.

Gregg Lerman

Greg Lerman has almost 40 years of experience as a criminal defense trial lawyer in Palm Beach County. He has worked directly with all divisions of the State attorney's office

County Court Judge, Group 2 of the 15 th Circuit Judiciary

The Fifteenth Judicial Circuit is comprised of five Circuit Court Divisions and 2 County Court Divisions. There are 35 circuit judges presiding and 19 county judges presiding. County Court Judge Ted Booras is not seeking reelection. *The following candidates for Circuit Court Judge, Group 2 attended the Alliance Candidates Forum:*

Jean Marie Middleton has a 38-year legal career practicing in complex civil litigation. She has served as legal counsel for several municipalities, two Fortune 500 companies and of the largest school district in the United States, including her current job as Assistant General Counsel for the Palm Beach County School District.

Office of the Public Defender of the 15 th Judicial Circuit:



Daniel Eisinger began his career in the Palm Beach County Public Defender Office in 2003 after earning his B.A. and J.D. from the University of Florida. Over the last 20 years, he has represented clients charged in misdemeanor, felony and major crime cases. He oversees 100 lawyers, 100 support staff with a budget of approximately 10 million dollars.

Adam Frankel

Adam Frankel began his legal career in the Palm Beach County Public Defender's office in 1999. He has been active in Palm Beach County Politics and Community Service for over 20 years. In 2009 Adam was first elected to the Delray Beach City Commission where he was reelected an additional four times. He has practiced as a criminal defense attorney for 23 years and has been endorsed and supported by law enforcement each time he ran for office.


