



Weather Update & Flood Control Instructions

This email provides instructions for property managers and homeowners associations with the responsibility of managing emergency operable discharge control structures. You are receiving this email because you are the designated flood control/drainage contact for your community or business, or have expressed an interest in your community's flood control operations. Residents with neighborhood flood control questions should contact their property manager or HOA regarding internal stormwater operations.

Current Conditions:

Potentially significant rain is possible throughout the weekend. LWDD water managers will monitor weather conditions throughout the weekend and make operational adjustments to canal elevations as needed.

Instructions:

Community discharge control structures should remain closed allowing for the natural progression of

drainage. Contact LWDD if you have any flooding issues or questions.

It is recommended to check storm drains and swale areas and clear any debris.
