This year's celebration was especially meaningful as we commemorated America's 250th birthday, reflecting on our past with optimism for generations to come.



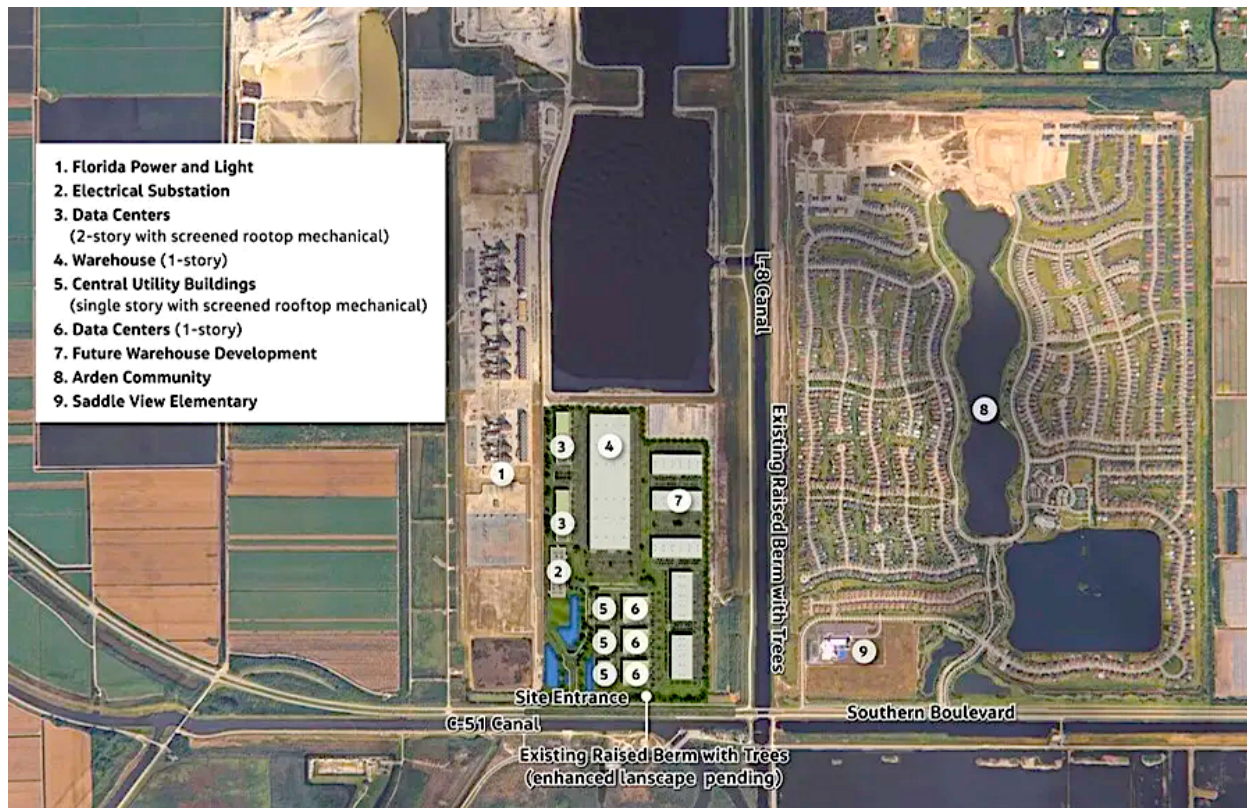
